**AMENDING SECTION 50-91 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE FOR
MICHIGAN CITY, INDIANA COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE FEE FOR
REDEMPTION OF IMPOUNDED ANIMALS AND THE ANIMAL SERVICES FUND**

WHEREAS, the City has previously enacted Sec. 50-91 in the Michigan City Municipal Code entitled "*Fee for Redemption of Impounded Animals*" which establishes an "*Animal Services Fund*;"

WHEREAS, Sec. 50-91 provides the Board of Public Works and Safety with the authority to contract with the Michiana Humane Society and Fried's Cat Shelter for their services promoting the well-being of animals, assisting abuse victims, and accepting and surrendering stray animals and that funds for these contracts shall be funded from the "*Animal Services Fund*" subject to appropriation by the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to amend Sec. 50-91 to do the following: 1.) add that the Board of Public Works and Safety has authority to also contract with the Independent Cat Society and the LaPorte County Small Animal Shelter; and 2.) allow the City Controller to equally divide the balance of the Animal Services Fund amongst the Michiana Humane Society, Fried's Cat Shelter, Independent Cat Society, and the LaPorte County Small Animal Shelter on a quarterly basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Michigan City that Sec. 50-91 of the Michigan City Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 50-91. Fee for redemption of impounded animals.

The fees required by Sec. 14-53 are established as follows:

- (1) Redemption fee. \$50.00 for the first time the animal is redeemed, and \$100.00 for each subsequent redemption.
- (2) If the animal is darted by the animal control authority as part of the impoundment process, the fee is \$50.00 **for each darting**.
- (3) The fines for the following violations shall be \$50.00 for each violation:
 - Dogs/cats running at large prohibited;
 - Dogs/cats on school grounds prohibited;
 - Dogs/cats creating nuisance prohibited;
 - Abandonment;
 - City dog/cat license required;
 - Duty of owner to protect dog/cat against rabies; and
 - Dog feces in yard for more than 72 hours.

In consideration of the Michiana Humane Society's, Fried's Cat Shelter's, the Independent Cat Society's, and the LaPorte County Small Animal Shelter's efforts to provide for the ethical care and treatment of animals, a non-reverting fund shall be created from revenues received in the General Fund entitled "Animal Services Fund." Sixty-six and six-tenths percent of all animal control related fees, limited to dog and cat license fees, animal redemption fees, darting fees, kennel license fees, and replacement of lost dog and cat license fees are to be credited to the "Animal Services Fund."

The Board of Public Works and Safety is empowered to enter into contracts with the Michiana Humane Society, Fried's Cat Shelter, Independent Cat Society, and the LaPorte County Small Animal Shelter:


- (1) To promote the well-being of our community's animals through intervention, advocacy and education.
- (2) To assist abuse victims.
- (3) To accept surrendered and stray animals when space permits.

These contracts shall be funded by the "Animal Services Fund" subject to the annual appropriation by the Common Council as required by law. The City Controller is directed

to equally divide the balance of the "Animal Services Fund" amongst the Michiana Humane Society, Fried's Cat Shelter, Independent Cat Society, and the LaPorte County Small Animal Shelter at the end of each calendar quarter.

This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2014, after the same has been passed by the Council, approval by the Mayor, any necessary publication, and any necessary approval by the Indiana Department of Local Government Finance.




