Call to Order: Shannon Eason

Attendees: Jane Daley, Shannon Eason, Judy Jacobi, Robin Kohn, Janet Bloch, Tim Haas, Rich Murphy, Craig Phillips

This special meeting was called together to discuss and make a decision on two topics that were time sensitive because of the work being done on Wabash Street and the conversion of some of the downtown streets from one way to two way streets.

Ms. Eason explained that the estimated cost to relocate the 2 sculptures, Red Green to the NW corner of 8th and Michigan Boulevard; Dasein to the sidewalk on the south side of City Hall is estimated to be \$4000. This amount includes approximately \$3000 for Marquiss Electric and approximately \$1000 estimated by Zach Baker to manage, coordinate and assist with the relocation. Mr. Phillips said that the Redevelopment Commission will cover the \$4,000 cost.

Motion

It was moved (Daley) and seconded (Haas) to move Red Green to the NW corner of 8th Street & Michigan Blvd. and to move Man in the City to the sidewalk on the south side of city hall. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Haas and Mr. Phillips explained that the sculpture known as "Clouds & Trees" will have to be moved because of the two way street conversion project. He ask that MAC help find some public property for this piece. He explained that all of this hinges on whether the artists family approves of the proposed relocation sites

Motion

It was moved (Daley) and seconded (Murphy) to move Clouds & Trees to Washington Park either on the west side of North Pointe Pavilion or the island just north of the employee parking lot, pending approval of the Michigan City Park Board of Directors. The motion carried unanimously.

Adjournment

The meeting adjourned at 3:00pm
