Minutes of the August 2, 2010, Michigan City Fire Merit Commission Meeting.

VicePresident Stimley called the meeting to order. A quorum was noted as present with Commissioners Keith Harris, John Stimley, and John Skierkowski, in attendance. Others present included Attorney Pam Krause, Chief Dave Lamb, Deputy Chief Randy Novak, Firefighter Tony Drzewiecki, and Recording Secretary, Gale Neulieb.

On a motion by Keith Harris, second by John Skierkowski the minutes of the July 12, 2010 meeting were approved as amended. **Motion 3-0.**

Attorney Krause had nothing to report.

Commissioner Skierkowski addressed the Commission regarding the agility testing that would be taking place Saturday and Sunday, August 7 & 8, 2010 and asked the Commissioners to be there by 7:00 a.m.

Commissioner Stimley thanked Chuck Greis for the thirty two (32) years of service stating he was an excellent firefighter.
