### ***DISCUSSION FORM HARBORMASTER***

Harbormaster Tim Frame discussed the following topics:

- Michigan City In-Water boat Show begins Thursday, August 21<sup>st</sup> thru Sunday, August 24<sup>th</sup>.
  - Tents will be going up on Wednesday, August 13<sup>th</sup>.
  - Restricted Parking through Labor Day; no visitor passes will be issued.
  - Thursday will be LaPorte County day; all residents get into show at no charge.
  - Slip holders may purchase discount tickets in the office. \$20 / 4 day pass.
- Handicapped Outing is Friday, August 15<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers can sign up in the office
- Boater Appreciation Picnic will be held on Saturday, August 16<sup>th</sup>.
- Boater Garage Sale will be held on Sunday, August 17<sup>th</sup>. No charge to sign up this year. Tables available on a first come, first serve basis.
- Turn off a/c when not staying on your boat. Raises marina electric costs and can be detrimental to your vessel.
- Boaters have not been adhering to the pet policy; reemphasized that dogs must be on a lease at all times unless on your boat.
- Return dock carts to designated area when done using.
- Gates are being blocked open.
- There has been some suspicious behavior reported in the east parking lot. Boaters are to call the police department, the majority of the parking areas belong to the Parks Department NOT the Port Authority.
