Each bidder shall be required to file with each bid a certified check or bidder's bond in the amount of One Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$100.00) or ten percent (10%) of each Bid,

whichever is greater. (A certified check shall be filed with each bid by a bidder not having his principal place of business in Indiana.) The Board of Public Works and Safety herewith reserves the right to waive any formality, informality, or irregularity in any bid or bids received and to reject any and all bids received. The successful bidder shall pay the balance due to the Controller within seven (7) days of being notified of the successful bid. A bidder who fails to pay the balance due forfeits the bidder's bond as liquidated damages and forfeits the right of purchase. The item, in such instance, may be sold to the next highest bidder. The successful bidder shall remove the property within five (5) days of payment or incur storage cost at Twenty and 00/100 Dollars (\$20.00) per day.
