American Hornbeam	<i>Carpinus caroliniana</i>	Mature height 30 feet
Ironwood	<i>Ostrya virginiana</i>	Mature height 30 feet
Ginkgo (male)	<i>Ginkgo biloba</i>	Mature height 50 feet
Blackgum	<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	Mature height 60 feet
