AMENDING SEC. 2-457(B)(2)(b)(2) IN THE MICHIGAN CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TO RECOGNIZE THAT THE MINORITY HEALTH COALITION IS NOW KNOWN AS THE COMMUNITY ADVOCATES OF NORTHERN INDIANA

WHEREAS, the City of Michigan City has a Women's Commission, Public Art Commission, and Human Rights Commission; and

WHEREAS, said Commissions have prescribed duties and responsibilities and each commission has established a donation fund which designates how the Commissions may spend said funds; and

WHEREAS, with the exception of the Public Art Commission, in Sec. 2-459(c)(6) and in Sec. 66-62(e), the Women's Commission and the Human Rights Commission have a duty to provide the Mayor and the Common Council with a report, at least annually, regarding their respective various activities, however, said Sections are silent as to what month said report should be submitted; and

WHEREAS, because the Commissions have recently and in the past received monies appropriated from the River Boat Fund, the Common Council reasonably believes that is in the best interest of the City and the residents herein that each Commission provide the Common Council and the Mayor with an annual written report each year in March summarizing the results of the Commissions' duties and responsibilities, providing recommendations for improvements, and also advising on the Commission's activities, spending, and financials; and

WHEREAS, with respect to the appointments made to the Social Status of African-American Males, seven (7) appoints are made by the Common Council, wherein (1) one of the (7) seven appointees shall come from a nomination from the Minority Health Coalition; and

WHEREAS, the Minority Health Coalition has changed its' name, and it is now known as Community Advocates of Northern Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the need exists to amend Sec. 2-467(B)(2)(b)(2) in the Michigan City Municipal Code to reflect the new name of Community Advocates of Northern Indiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Michigan City, Indiana, as follows:

1. The following paragraph shall be added to Sec. 2-458(e) of the Michigan City Municipal Code, specifically at the end of the existing paragraph in said section, pertaining to the Public Art Committee:

In addition, the Commission shall report annually, in writing, summarizing the results of each of their duties and responsibilities, and provide recommendations for improvements to the Mayor and the Common Council. In addition, said report shall contain information regarding the Commission's activities, spending, and financials. A representative from the Commission shall appear at the first Common Council meeting in March to present said written report to the Common Council.

2. Sec. 2-459(c)(6) of the Michigan City Municipal Code pertaining to the Women's Commission shall be amended to now read as follows:
 - (6) Report annually, in writing, summarizing the results of each of their duties and responsibilities, and provide recommendations for improvements to the Mayor and the Common Council. In addition, said report shall contain information regarding the Commission's activities, spending, and financials. A representative from the

Commission shall appear at the first Common Council meeting in March to present said written report to the Common Council.

- 3. Sec. 66-62(e) of the Michigan City Municipal Code pertaining to the Human Rights Commission shall be amended to now read as follows:

Report annually, in writing, summarizing the results of each of their duties and responsibilities, and provide recommendations for improvements to the Mayor and the Common Council. In addition, said report shall contain information regarding the Commission’s activities, spending, and financials, including describing in detail the investigation and conciliation proceedings it has conducted and the outcome thereof. A representative from the Commission shall appear at the first Common Council meeting in March to present said written report to the Common Council.

- 4. Sec. 2-457(B)(2)(b)(2) of the Michigan City Municipal Code shall read as follows:

One member nominated by the Community Advocates of Northern Indiana (formerly known as the Minority Health Coalition).

CREATING SECTION 2-410 IN CHAPTER 2 OF THE MICHIGAN CITY MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE CUMMULATIVE CHANNEL MAINTENANCE FUND

WHEREAS, on July 18, 1995 the Common Council enacted Resolution No. 3771 entitled “*Resolution Determining to Establish a Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund*” and said Resolution was approved by the Mayor on July 19, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 3771 established a Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund to specifically provide funds “... *to dredge channels, to repair bulkheads, pilings, docks and wharves, and for funds with which to maintain and operate existing facilities erected and constructed and repaired by Cumulative Channel Maintenance Funds in the past, and all located within the territorial jurisdiction of the Port Authority of the City of Michigan City, Indiana...*” by virtue of a tax levy of “...*Five Cents (\$.05) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of taxable personal and real property within the taxing district...*” and

WHEREAS, on 12th day of February, 2018, the Board of Directors of the Michigan City Port Authority enacted a Resolution entitled “*Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Michigan City Port Authority Recommending an Amendment to Resolution No. 3771,*” recommending that the Common Council add the following as a permissible use of the Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund pursuant to I.C 8-10-5-17(a)(5): “*Regulation and enforcement of regulation of all uses and activities related to waters that are under the jurisdiction of the Port Authority;*” and

WHEREAS, in addition, pursuant to Port Authority’s aforementioned Resolution, assuming said recommendation is adopted by the Common Council, the Board of Directors of the Michigan City Port Authority supports the use of the Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund for the installation of security cameras along the East Pier and Lot One of Washington Park, which they believe will substantially improve the enforcement of regulation of all uses related to the waters that are under the jurisdiction of the Michigan City Port Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council desires to implement the recommendations by the Board of Directors of the Michigan City Port Authority and reasonably believes that the use of the Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund for “*regulation and enforcement of regulation of all uses and activities related to waters that are under the jurisdiction of the Port Authority*” is in the best interest of the City and its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council further desires that the Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund be codified in the Michigan City Municipal Code under Chapter 2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Michigan City, Indiana, that Section 2-410 shall be created in Chapter 2 of the Michigan City Municipal Code and shall read as follows:

Sec. 2-410. Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund. Common Council Resolution No. 3771 created the Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund and provided that there be levied an additional tax of Five Cents (\$.05) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of taxable personal and real property within the Port Authority’s taxing district to provide monies for the Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund. This Fund shall be a restricted, non-reverting fund. The purpose of this Fund shall be to provide funding for the following:

- a. Dredging of channels;
- b. Repairing bulkheads, pilings, docks, and wharfs;
- c. Maintaining and operating existing facilities erected, constructed, and repaired by the Cumulative Channel Maintenance Funds; and
- d. Regulation and enforcement of regulation of all uses and activities related to waters that are under the jurisdiction of the Port Authority.

The City shall not use the funds in its Cumulative Channel Maintenance Fund for any other purposes than those stated herein and such funds shall be administered by the Controller.

- 1. The position of Maintenance Craftsman shall be added to Section 1 of Ordinance No. 4454, specifically under the Park Zoo in the Park Department, and shall read as follows:

Table with 2 columns: Position, Annual Salary or Rate per Hour. Row 1: Maintenance Craftsman, \$8.25 - \$8.75

- 2. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 4454 shall remain in full force and effect.

WHEREAS, it has been demonstrated to the Common Council of the City of Michigan City that it is necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the 2018 Annual Budget to provide funding of \$10,000.00 each to the Michigan City Public Art Commission, the Michigan City Commission on Women, and the Social Status of African-American Males Commission to support each of their respective projects and programs; and
