# AMENDING SECTION 62-31 OF THE MICHIGAN CITY MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING MEMBERSHIP ON THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Common Council desires to make amendments to that part of the Michigan City Municipal Code regarding eligibility for membership on the City's Historic Preservation Commission to remove any appearance of undue influence or conflict of interest due a member's official association with City government;

WHEREAS, the Common Council reasonable believes these amendments are in the best interest of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Common Council of the City of Michigan City as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Sec. 66-31(a) and (b) of the Michigan City Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

#### Sec. 66-31. Established; membership; term of members; vacanices

- (a) There is established the city Historic Preservation Commission. The Commission shall consist of nine (9) voting member. The voting members shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to the approval of the Common Council. Of the members appointed, at least one (1) shall be an architect with a state architectural certification, at least one (1) shall own or lease property in a designated historic district, at least one shall be a City registered contractor who is not an employee of the City, at least one (1) shall be a member of the City's Redevelopment Commission, and one shall be a member of the City Plan Commission. All members shall have an interest in the preservation and development of historic buildings and areas. Voting members shall serve a term of three (3) years. A vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the term of the member who is being replaced. Voting members shall be residents of the City who are interested in the research, restoration, rehabilitation, conservation, and development of historic areas. No member of the Commission shall be an employee or contractor or subcontractor for the City or other City board or commission except as, and only to the extent, otherwise specified above as a qualification for membership.
