Subject: Drainage Workshop

Mayor Meer invites all members of the Michigan City Common Council to a workshop to be held in the EOC Room in City Hall at 5:00 pm on August 29, 2017 to receive information and engage in discussions regarding a proposed drainage fee for Michigan City. Each member of the Council has been provided extensive documentation providing the reasons why the Council is being asked to consider approving a drainage fee and the workshop will consist of Sanitary District staff, attorney, and financial consultant discussing and elaborating on the information provided, providing additional information, and answering any questions any Council member may have regarding the proposed drainage fee. While the workshop will be open to the public to attend, questions and comments will only be accepted from Council members. After this workshop, there will be several public meetings in different areas of the City at which the public will be able to comment and ask questions regarding the proposed drainage fee. In addition, of course, the Council typically allows public comment at any meeting at which an ordinance approving the fee is on the agenda.
