2. All letters should be clearly written and all words spelled correctly.
3. Each poster must have an entry form stapled to it.
4. The contestant's name or school must not appear on the poster.
5. All entries must be submitted by 4:00 p.m. on January 31, 2012 to the Human Rights Commission Office.
6. Posters should not exceed 11" x 17".
7. Failure to adhere to contest rules may result in disqualification of entry.

Posters will be exhibited at the Lubeznik Center for the Arts.
