Handgun License Information

1. Applications for **renewals** and **new** handgun permits are now accepted online. Go to the following web address: <http://www.aries.in.gov/Firearms/Permit.aspx>. You will still need to come to the Michigan City Police Station with your two (2) money orders, your photo identification, and to have your fingerprints taken to complete the application process.
2. The money order for the local fee should be made out to the **Michigan City Police** or **MCPD**. The other money order for the state fee should be made out to the **State of Indiana**. The amount must correspond with the specific permit you are applying for.
3. Applicants without access to a computer can apply for handgun permits at The Michigan City Police Department **Monday - Friday from 8:00 am - 3:30 pm.**

Note: the Personal Protection License also covers Hunting and Target License

4. **You must live within the corporate city limits of Michigan City and be a resident of Indiana.** If you live outside the corporate city limits of Michigan City address you must apply at the LaPorte County Sheriff's Department.
5. Handgun License renewals may not be applied for more than one hundred eighty (180) days prior to the expiration of your current license.
6. You may not have a Handgun License if you have been convicted of a **FELONY**, to include Felony D.U.I. (second offense of Driving While Intoxicated) or Domestic Battery.
7. Any person giving false information or false evidence to obtain a Handgun License shall be deemed guilty of a Felony. Upon conviction, you may be punished by imprisonment for five (5) years to which a fine of \$10,000 may be added.
