CITY LEAF PICK-UP

Michigan City, IN - Central Services Superintendent Jim Elwell and Mayor Chuck Oberlie provided the following update on City Leaf Pick-Up:

“City Street Dept. crews will continue working in Area 3 through Saturday, November 21st while Refuse Department crews will begin working in area 1 (west of Franklin Street).

Beginning Monday, November 23rd, leaf removal crews will begin working 12 hour shifts. The public is asked to be vigilant of the workers and to not park on leaf piles.”

Mayor Oberlie is requesting that residents cooperate by following these rules:

- **No plastic bags are to be used.**
- **Branches, rocks and other debris must be kept out of the leaf piles.**
- **Leaf piles should be loose in large piles in front of the property as close to the curb as possible, but away from the sewer drains.**

Mayor Oberlie stated, “I would like to thank the employees of the Street and Refuse Departments for their great effort to remove the leaves. I would also like to thank the public for their patience as we continue to expedite the leaf pick-up.”

Beginning Monday, November 23rd, our crews will begin in the final pick-up in Area 1 and continue through Areas 2 and 3. Crews will make one pass on each street.
