Michigan City, IN (June 10, 2004) Chief of Police Gene Simmons announced the results of the Michigan City Police Department's participation in the Governor's Council on Impaired & Dangerous Driving. City Police Officers worked Operation Pull Over in May of 2004 with the following results:

- 61 Seat Belt Citations Issued
- 02 Child Restraint Citations Issued
- 04 Suspended License Citations Issued
- 02 other License Violation Citations Issued
- 06 other Traffic Offenses Enforced
- 05 Criminal Misdemeanor Arrests Made
- 01 Criminal Felony Arrest Made
- 81 Total Warnings & Citations Issued

Michigan City Police Officers Conducted 6 Seat Belt Patrols resulting in:

- 51 Seat Belt Citations Issued
- 04 Child Restraint Citations Issued
- 02 Suspended License Citations Issued
- 01 other License Violation Citations Issued
- 04 Other Traffic Offenses Enforced
- 01 Criminal Misdemeanor Arrests Made
- 01 Criminal Felony Arrest Made
- 76 Total Warnings & Citations Issued

Operation Pullover totals in May:

- 145 Total Citations Issued
- 12 Total Warning Citations Issued
- 6 Misdemeanor Arrests Made
- 2 Felony Arrests Made
