MAYOR ANNOUNCES AVIATION BOARD APPOINTEE

Michigan City, IN - Mayor Chuck Oberlie announced today the appointment of Greg Poulin to a four-year term on the Aviation Board.

“The Aviation Board has been working diligently to finalize and implement a thorough and detailed long range strategic plan for the Michigan City Airport and Mr. Poulin will prove to be an asset in these efforts,” Mayor Oberlie said. “With an engineering degree and eight years experience as a U.S. Navy pilot, Greg is an outstanding addition to the Aviation Board.”

Poulin was born and raised in Brunswick, Maine, and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Marine Engineering from Maine Maritime Academy. After college, Poulin received a commission to the U.S. Navy, successfully completed flight school and served approximately eight years as a Navy pilot, followed by four years of service in the Naval Reserves.

Poulin moved to Michigan City in 1998 to accept a position with Blue Chip Casino as a marine engineer and is currently employed by Trump Casino as Chief Engineer. After moving to Michigan City, he met and married local resident Laure Kissinger. They have a young daughter with a second child expected by the end of this month.

He is an active member of the Michigan City Lions Club and is also the current President of the Kimball Woods Homeowners Association.

“I am looking forward to my appointment to the Aviation Board,” Poulin said. “I have always had a strong interest in aviation and currently hold a commercial pilot license.”
