Organizations that provide services to the Citizens of Michigan City and qualify as 501(c)(3) tax-exempt entities by the Internal Revenue Service are eligible for funding from the Michigan City Community Enrichment Corporation. The Enrichment Corporation plans to award \$750,000 in grant monies that will benefit the Community in December of this year!
