CITY LEAF PICK-UP

Michigan City, IN – Central Services Superintendent Jim Elwell provided the following update on City Leaf Pick-Up this fall:

“As a result of the weather conditions that led to the rapid falling of leaves throughout the City, the Area 1 pick-up scheduled for completion last Saturday has been revised to be completed this Saturday, November 20th.”

Beginning on Monday, November 22nd, City crews will then move into Area 2 and make every effort to complete Area 2 by Saturday, November 27th. In spite of the Thanksgiving Holiday, the Street Dept. crews will be working on Saturday during Thanksgiving weekend.

Area 3 leaf pick-up will then begin on Monday, November 29th.

Refuse Department and Sanitary District staff have been assisting and will continue to assist the Street Department with leaf pick-up this fall in order to make as much progress as possible from week to week.

We appreciate the public’s patience as we will continue to expedite the leaf pick-up through the targeted areas over the next 2-1/2 weeks.

Beginning on Monday, December 6th, City staff are expected to be available to respond to special calls for leaf pick-up. On December 6th, citizens should call the Street Department at 873-1500 for leaf pick-up service calls. The calls will be logged in as they are received and staff will be dispatched as they become available to complete the leaf pick-up for this fall.
