The Moving Wall Update

Michigan City, IN (August 24, 2005) - The Moving Wall, a transportable version of the Vietnam Veteran's Memorial in Washington, D.C., will be in Fedder's Alley, Washington Park, Michigan City, Indiana, through August 26, 2005. There is no admission fee charged to visit The Moving Wall which will be open to the public 24-hours daily until 6 p.m. (CST) on August 26th when The Moving Wall will be dismantled for shipment to another community. The National POW/MIA flag, a privately owned thirty foot by sixty foot flag, will fly near The Moving Wall during its visit.

The Washington Park Zoo will honor veterans and military personnel during Patriot Week at the Zoo, August 19 – 26. Any military personnel or veterans in uniform or with appropriate identification will receive free entry to the historic Washington Park Zoo during the week of The Moving Wall's appearance in Michigan City.
