Michigan City, IN (August 8, 2003) – Human Rights Department Director Nancy Widelski announced an addition to the department's web pages that will make a difference in the lives of some Michigan City residents.

“Visit the Human Rights Department webpages,” said Director Widelski, “and you'll find information about our services, how to reach us, and what information we need to be able to help with a discrimination problem...all in Spanish. This department also has an interpreter available for people who speak Spanish.”

Mayor Chuck Oberlie said, “Just over 3 per cent of our current population is, according to the Census Bureau, Hispanic. By adding a short Spanish translation of the most important information regarding the Human Rights Department, we will now be able to provide assistance to people whom we might not have reached before, and by doing so, we will have helped to make life better in our community.”
