Top 12 Code Violations

Each month, the Michigan City Public Safety Team will publicize one of the twelve most frequently violated city codes. The Public Safety Team is a component of Mayor Chuck Oberlie's "AIM HIGH" initiative which brings together city department heads to identify and resolve issues facing the city's residents and visitors.

July's Code of the Month is: **Loud Noise**

Examples of loud noises include music from auto radios, music from 'boom boxes,' music from stereo systems inside and outside homes, car mufflers, etc. To learn more about this code, ask for City Ordinance #999.019 or visit "Online City Hall" at www.emichigancity.com and click on "municipal codes."

What can you do?

Be a good neighbor. Keep your music turned down to a reasonable level whether you're in your car, your yard or your home. For your safety as well as compliance with municipal code, keep your muffler in good repair.

What if you don't comply?

You can be fined and ordered to appear in court.
