- Stay in neighborhoods you know and only trick-or-treat at houses that are well lit.
- Always walk on sidewalks and driveways, never in the street or through people's yards.
- Don't eat any of your treats until you and your parents check them over and throw away the treats that don't have wrappers. It is always a good idea to cut large treats and fruit into bite-size pieces. Also never pick up a treat off the ground, even if it is still in its wrapper.
- Never accept a ride from a stranger.
