

SPECIAL “HYBRID/ZOOM” MEETING

May 5, 2022

The Common Council of the City of Michigan City, Indiana, met in SPECIAL session on Thursday evening, May 5, 2022, at the hour of 7:00 p.m., Hosted by “Hybrid/Zoom” and streamed live on “My Michigan City” Facebook Page.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Council President Angie Nelson Deutch.

President Deutch stated that this “Special Meeting” was scheduled to appoint a “hearing officer” for charges that were brought fourth by the administration against the commissioners of the Michigan City Housing Authority.

Roll call was authorized, and the following were noted present and/or absent.

A QUORUM WAS NOTED PRESENT

ALSO, PRESENT: Gale Neulieb City Clerk.

President Deutch advised that prior to this “Special” Council meeting they held an executive session at 6:30 p.m. to discuss the initiation of litigation, as either pending or has been threatened specifically in writing; stating that there were no decisions made in that executive session.

VOTE

President Deutch advised that on our agenda is a vote for a “Hearing Officer”, entertaining a motion.

Councilman P. Przybylinski made a motion to appoint Attorney Gerald Bishop as mediator “Hearing Officer” and to appoint Attorney Patrick Lyp as alternate “Hearing Officer in case anything happens he will be able to move forward and be up to date if necessary, a second was made by Council Fitzpatrick.
