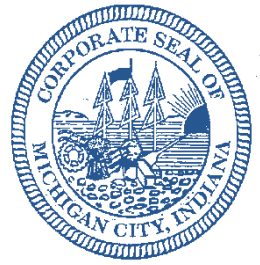

Recently the City of LaPorte withdrew from the Transit Triangle. The Transit Triangle originated as a commuter service for quick, convenient, and economical connections between LaPorte, Michigan City, and Westville.

The **BONUS** to this program is the connection of the Purdue Northwest Campus giving students the accessibility to get a ride to college for fifty cents!

Mayor Parry is an advocate of this essential program connecting our two cities and assisting the college students of LaPorte County. Michigan City will fund the program through the Federal Cares Act Grant. This new route also offers convenient rides to the Cancer Treatment Center and Surgery center on 400 North, along with a stop at the Swanson Center!

On another note he has additionally decided, due to the unfortunate year with COVID-19, he will extend FREE bus rides through the summer! We will then begin to charge again in September of this year.
